

Recent Adult Program Attendance at Vineyard Haven Public Library, 2016-2018*

- 137 events for adults in 25 months, mid-September 2016 to mid-October 2018
- Total Attendance 5,273
- Average Attendance 38
- Average Attendance for July/August events was 53.
- Average attendance at “off-season” events was 35, but 35 events had attendance greater than 45.
- Number of events over 100 attendees: 5 (4%). Highest attendance was 125.
- Number of events over 70 attendees: 13 (9.5%)
- Number of events over 60 attendees: 28 (17%)
- Number of events over 45 attendees: 46 (34%)
- 24 events held at Katharine Cornell Theater. Average attendance at KCT was 65. 16 events had attendance greater than 60.
- 113 events were held at 200 Main Street Library. Of these, 26 (23%) had more than 45 attendees , 7 had more than 60 attendees, and 2 had more than 100 attendees.
